



## TERMS & CONDITIONS – TIPIAC MEMBERSHIP

**Last updated: April 2026**

This Agreement is between you (**You**) and TIPIAC PTY LTD (ABN 98 646 508 698) (**TIPIAC**) and governs Your TIPIAC Membership. This Agreement expressly incorporates TIPIAC's Privacy Policy.

### BACKGROUND

- (A) TIPIAC is an Indigenous-owned and operated company that assists teachers and schools to deliver practical solutions for embedding First Nations knowledge and perspectives into teaching and learning.
- (B) Bilaar AI is a platform grounded in the wisdom and knowledge systems of First Nations peoples. Bilaar AI honours Indigenous Cultural and Intellectual Property (**ICIP**) and integrates over 65,000 years of First Nations history, culture, and ways of knowing into its tools and resources.
- (C) Bilaar AI, is built on the following guiding principles:
  - (i) Upholding and protecting ICIP by ensuring that all knowledge shared through Bilaar AI is culturally respectful, accurate, and sourced with consent.
  - (ii) Recognising the significance of First Nations knowledge holders, Elders, and communities as stewards of culture and history.
  - (iii) Emphasising the importance of relationships with Country, community, and each other in all aspects of learning and teaching.
  - (iv) Encouraging practices that honour the natural world and foster a mindset of care for the environment.
  - (v) Supporting educators to engage in meaningful conversations about Australia's history and the diverse perspectives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
- (D) You wish to subscribe to one of TIPIAC's Memberships to access certain TIPIAC Resources and/or Bilaar AI, either as an individual teacher or on behalf of a school.
- (E) TIPIAC agrees to provide access to certain TIPIAC Resources and use of the Bilaar AI platform on the terms of this Agreement.

### 2. TERM

- (a) This Agreement sets out the terms and conditions on which TIPIAC will provide TIPIAC Resources and access to Bilaar AI to You.
- (b) By signing up for a TIPIAC Membership, or otherwise using TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI, You accept the terms and conditions provided in this Agreement. If You do not agree to the terms of this Agreement, then You must not use the TIPIAC Membership or access any of the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI.
- (c) This Agreement commences on the date on which You accept the terms and conditions provided in this Agreement and, continues until the earlier of:



- (i) the expiry of the Initial Subscription Period or Renewal Subscription Period in accordance with clause 3(d)(iii) and clause 4(d); or
  - (ii) by termination of this Agreement in accordance with clause 11,
- (the **Term**).

### 3. SUBSCRIPTION

- (a) Subject to clause 2(b) and 2(c), TIPIAC agrees to provide You with access to TIPIAC Resources and/or Bilaar AI for the Subscription Period under clause 3(d)(iii).
- (b) You acknowledge and agree that access to TIPIAC Resources and/or Bilaar AI depends on which TIPIAC Membership You have selected, as set out and described in Schedule 1 – Memberships.
- (c) You will become a member by registering an account via TIPIAC’s website and in accordance with clause 3(d) (**Member**).
- (d) To register as a Member, You must:
  - (i) input a username and password;
  - (ii) select a Membership, as set out in clause 3(b) and Schedule 1 – Memberships;
  - (iii) select a period that is either month to month or one year at the time of registration (**Subscription Period**);
  - (iv) provide a valid credit card or other payment details for the purpose of paying the applicable Membership Fee;
  - (v) provide TIPIAC with any information reasonably requested, including but not limited to:
    - (A) Your:
      1. full legal name,
      2. postal address,
      3. email address,
      4. mobile phone number, and
    - (B) confirmation of whether You are a representative of a school;
    - (C) subject to confirmation of being a school representative under clause 3(d)(v)(B), provide:
      1. the name of the school entity and ABN,
      2. postal address,
      3. email address,
      4. mobile phone number, and
    - (D) bank account or credit card details used for paying the Membership Fee;
  - (vi) for Gold Ochre and Whole School Memberships, provide the teaching level for which the TIPIAC

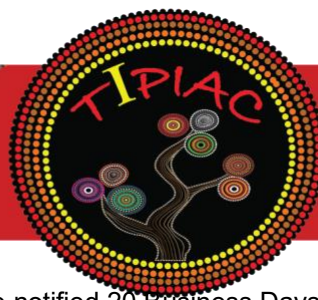


Resources will be used.

- (e) You agree to be responsible for:
  - (i) maintaining the security of Your username and password provided under clause 3(d)(i).
  - (ii) ensuring that Your account information is up to date.
- (f) Where You hold a Bilaar AI Single Teacher Membership, Red Ochre or Gold Ochre Membership, You must not share Your user identification details and password with any other person.
- (g) Where You hold a Bilaar AI Small, Medium or Large Membership, or a Whole School Membership, You can designate 100 additional people as account holders. You must not (and must use reasonable endeavours to ensure that designated account holders do not) share Your user identification details and password with any other person.

#### 4. PAYMENT & GST

- (a) Subject to the TIPIAC Membership You have selected under clause 3(b) and clause 3(d)(ii), and the Subscription Period, You agree to pay TIPIAC a Membership Fee:
  - (i) on an annual basis; or
  - (ii) on a month-to-month basis,in advance, with the first payment to be made when You register Your account.
- (b) You agree to pay the Membership Fee by credit card through our secure third-party online service located at [www.stripe.com/au](http://www.stripe.com/au).
- (c) You will receive a confirmation email and receipt for each transaction of the Membership Fee.
- (d) Following the end of the selected Subscription Period under clause 3(d)(iii) (the **Initial Subscription Period**), You agree that this agreement will be automatically renewed for successive Subscription Periods for the same term as the Initial Subscription Period (**Renewal Subscription Period**), unless:
  - (i) TIPIAC notifies You that it does not wish to renew the Agreement, at least:
    - (A) For a month-to-month payment arrangement 5 Business Days; or
    - (B) For an annual payment arrangement 15 Business Days,before the end of the Initial Subscription Period or any Renewal Subscription Period, in which case this Agreement will expire at the end of the Initial Subscription Period or the current Renewal Subscription Period;
  - (ii) You cancel Your TIPIAC Membership at any time in accordance with clause 11(d); or
  - (iii) Your subscription is otherwise terminated in accordance with this Agreement.
- (e) If a payment fails, access to TIPIAC Membership may be suspended until the payment is successfully processed.
- (f) Membership Fees are not refundable, except as expressly set out in this Agreement.



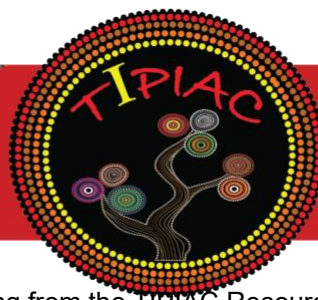
- (g) Pricing is subject to change, and You will be notified 20 Business Days in advance of any changes being implemented to the Membership Fee. You will be entitled to terminate this Agreement by providing written notice to TIPIAC no later than 5 Business Days before the change is due to take effect and any prepaid Membership Fee will be refunded on a pro-rated basis.

## 5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- (a) TIPIAC own or have rights to the TIPIAC Resources, including but not limited to, images, photographs, graphics, artwork, text and other material used in the TIPIAC Resources and on TIPIAC's website, including the Intellectual Property rights therein.
- (b) To the extent allowed at law, the Parties agree that TIPIAC owns the Bilaar AI Output and TIPIAC can deal with them as though they are the owners of the Intellectual Property rights therein.
- (c) This Agreement does not assign any Intellectual Property rights to You.
- (d) TIPIAC grants You a non-assignable, non-exclusive worldwide licence to use and access the TIPIAC Resource and Bilaar AI Output during Your Subscription Period or the Renewed Subscription Period, for Non-Commercial Purposes.
- (e) You grant TIPIAC a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free licence to use, reproduce, store, process, analyse, and adapt any Bilaar AI Inputs for the purposes of operating, providing, maintaining, and improving Bilaar AI and the TIPIAC Resources, including for system development and enhancement, in accordance with this Agreement.
- (f) You must not use the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output for any Commercial Purpose.
- (g) You must not reproduce, modify, distribute, publish, or share the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output except as permitted under this Agreement or as reasonably required for Non-Commercial Purposes.
- (h) You must not use TIPIAC's trade marks, name or branding, except as displayed on the TIPIAC Resources and Bilaar AI Output, without our prior written permission.
- (i) The operation of this clause survives expiry or termination of this Agreement.

## 6. CREDIT AND INTEGRITY

- (a) You will, and will ensure Your personnel and students, will:
- (i) attribute TIPIAC as the source of the TIPIAC Resources and Bilaar AI Output, and as the copyright owner;
  - (ii) where identified, appropriately attribute the relevant authors;
  - (iii) not alter, adapt or modify TIPIAC resources, except as permitted under this Agreement or unless approved in writing by TIPIAC;
  - (iv) only alter or adapt Bilaar AI Output to the extent reasonably necessary for teaching and learning (for example, summarising, rewording or incorporating into classroom activities) and only in ways that are accurate and not misleading;
  - (v) not use any TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output in a way that is misleading, offensive, or harmful to the reputation of the authors or TIPIAC; and



- (vi) not remove any of TIPIAC's branding from the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output.
- (b) The operation of this clause survives expiry or termination of this Agreement.

## **7. INDIGENOUS CULTURAL AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

- (a) The parties acknowledge and agree that to the extent that ICIP is included, incorporated, referenced or captured in the TIPIAC Resources and Bilaar AI Output, ownership of the ICIP will remain with the relevant traditional owners or custodians of the ICIP.
- (b) As a condition of Your access and use, You agree to:
  - (i) comply with any cultural protocols, restrictions on use of any ICIP about which TIPIAC notifies You from time to time;
  - (ii) ensure that where identified the relevant traditional owners or custodians are and continue to be acknowledged and recognised as the owners of the ICIP incorporated, referenced or captured in the TIPIAC Resources and Bilaar AI Output;
  - (iii) use all ICIP, resources, and materials accessed through TIPIAC in a culturally respectful, ethical and lawful manner, and in accordance with any TIPIAC guidelines as updated from time to time;
  - (iv) only use ICIP obtained through Your TIPIAC Membership in accordance with, and subject to, the licence granted under this agreement, You may not repurpose, redistribute, or commercialise this knowledge without explicit written consent from TIPIAC.
- (c) You will ensure that Your personnel and students comply with this clause in any use of the TIPIAC Resources.
- (d) The operation of this clause survives expiry or termination of this Agreement.

## **8. USE OF TIPIAC RESOURCES – USER OBLIGATIONS**

- (a) You must notify TIPIAC if You become aware of any use of the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output (including any ICIP) by someone who does not have rights to use those resources.
- (b) You must not:
  - (i) represent that You own the Intellectual Property rights in any of the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output;
  - (ii) represent that You own any ICIP included, incorporated, referenced or captured in the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output;
  - (iii) use the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Outputs in a way that is disparaging to TIPIAC, the traditional custodians and owners of ICIP, or Indigenous peoples; or
  - (iv) use the TIPIAC Resources for Commercial Purposes, without explicit written consent from TIPIAC.
- (c) You must not:
  - (i) share Your username and password with any other person (except as permitted above if You have a Whole School membership); or



- (ii) provide the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output to any person who is not one of Your students or a designated account holder.
- (d) If You hold a Whole School Membership, You must use reasonable endeavours to ensure that designated account holders comply with clause 8.

## 9. PRIVACY

- (a) When You access TIPIAC's website (including the TIPIAC Resources and Bilaar AI), You consent to TIPIAC's collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information about You, as set out in the TIPIAC Privacy Policy.
- (b) The parties agree to:
  - (i) comply with the Australian Privacy Principles pursuant to the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth);
  - (ii) only use Personal Information held or controlled by it in connection with this Agreement for the purposes of fulfilling its obligations under this Agreement; and
  - (iii) take all reasonable measures to ensure that Personal Information in its possession or control in connection with this Agreement is protected against loss and authorised access, use, modification or disclosure.

## 10. PRODUCT CHANGES

- (a) TIPIAC reserves the right to modify its website including Bilaar AI and the TIPIAC Resources, including updating, adding or removing resources, website features or functionality.
- (b) TIPIAC may discontinue its website including Bilaar AI and / or the TIPIAC Resources in its absolute discretion by reasonable written notice to You. TIPIAC are not liable to You for any compensation or claim caused by any discontinuance, except for a pro-rated refund of the Membership Fee for any unused period, if applicable.

## 11. TERMINATION

- (a) Either party has the right to terminate this Agreement by notice in writing to the other party if the other party commits a breach of this Agreement and either:
  - (i) the breach is material and not capable of being cured; or
  - (ii) the breach is capable of being cured and the defaulting party fails to cure the breach within seven days of being notified in writing of the breach by the party giving the notice.
- (b) TIPIAC may terminate this Agreement or suspend Your Membership by notice in writing to You, if You hold a Bilaar Single Teacher, Red Ochre or Gold Ochre Membership and You share Your username and password with another person.
- (c) If TIPIAC terminate this Agreement in accordance with clause 11(a) or (b):
  - (i) Your membership will end immediately, and You must not access TIPIAC Resources; and
  - (ii) You will not be refunded for any remaining period of Your Initial Subscription Period or Renewal Subscription Period.



- (d) You may cancel Your TIPIAC Membership at any time by logging into Your account via TIPIAC's website and selecting the "Cancel Membership" option.
- (e) If You cancel your TIPIAC Membership under clause 11(d), You will:
  - (i) receive a cancellation confirmation email from TIPIAC;
  - (ii) continue to have access to the TIPIAC Membership and the TIPIAC Resources until the end of the Initial Subscription Period or the Renewed Subscription Period; and
  - (iii) not be refunded for unused time.

## 12. DISCLAIMERS & WARRANTIES

- (a) The TIPIAC Membership and TIPIAC Resources are provided on an 'as is' basis, and to the maximum extent permitted by law, including the Australian Consumer Law, TIPIAC makes no express or implied warranties or representations, and disclaims all responsibility from:
  - (i) the completeness, accuracy, or currency of the TIPIAC Resources;
  - (ii) the standard or quality of the TIPIAC Resources;
  - (iii) uninterrupted or error free access to TIPIAC Resources, or that they will be free from Malicious Computer Programs;
  - (iv) the security of the TIPIAC Resources or TIPIAC's website including Bilaar AI; or
  - (v) the TIPIAC Resources meeting Yours or Your personnel's individual requirements, and You acknowledge that the TIPIAC Resources are standardised and general, and are not tailored to Your particular requirements.
- (b) TIPIAC represents and warrants to You that:
  - (i) It owns the TIPIAC Resources and Bilaar AI Outputs, or where TIPIAC does not own them, has the necessary rights to provide and license them under this Agreement;
  - (ii) It has used its reasonable endeavours to ensure that any ICIP included in the TIPIAC Resources has been incorporated with appropriate permissions or in accordance with applicable protocols
  - (iii) Provision of TIPIAC Membership and TIPIAC Resources (excluding Bilaar AI Outputs) will not infringe the Intellectual Property rights of any third party.
- (c) You represent and warrant to TIPIAC that:
  - (i) You have the right and authority to enter into this Agreement;
  - (ii) You have all necessary rights, licences and permissions to provide the materials to TIPIAC and to authorise TIPIAC to use them under this Agreement, and that such materials do not infringe the rights (including Intellectual Property rights) of any third party;
  - (iii) You will comply with any Bilaar AI guiding principles as notified by TIPIAC from time to time;



- (iv) You will not upload and include in Billaar AI Inputs (either intentionally or inadvertently) any private, health, cultural, Personal Information, confidential, or Sensitive Information, or any content that is unlawful, defamatory, discriminatory or otherwise harmful, in Billaar AI Inputs, and will only use Billaar AI and the Billaar AI Outputs for Non-Commercial Purposes.
- (d) The operation of this clause survives expiry or termination of this Agreement.

### 13. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- (a) While TIPIAC will use reasonable care and skill in operating their website, TIPIAC cannot promise that the website will always be available or completely free of faults or errors.
- (b) To the maximum extent permitted by law, except as expressly set out in the Agreement, TIPIAC will not be liable for any direct or indirect loss, liability, costs, damages or expenses which may be suffered by You as a result of:
  - (i) You or Your personnel's access or use of TIPIAC Resources and/or any other information or material contained in or on the same;
  - (ii) the unavailability, inaccessibility or interruption of usage of the TIPIAC Membership and TIPIAC Resources;
  - (iii) content, information or materials contained in the TIPIAC Membership and TIPIAC Resources;
  - (iv) any delay or failure in performance of the TIPIAC Membership and TIPIAC Resources beyond TIPIAC's reasonable control;
  - (v) loss of data;
  - (vi) the TIPIAC Membership and TIPIAC Resources not being sufficient for Your purposes or requirements.
- (c) To the maximum extent permitted by law, TIPIAC are not responsible for any indirect special or consequential liability to You or Your personnel arising out of or from material, access or use of the TIPIAC Membership and TIPIAC Resources.
- (d) To the maximum extent permitted by law, TIPIAC limit its liability to You, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise, to Your annual Membership Fee.
- (e) To the extent that any implied warranty or statutory guarantee cannot be excluded by law, TIPIAC's liability for breach of that warranty or guarantee will be limited to TIPIAC's choice of re-supplying the applicable resources or paying the cost of any such re-supply.
- (f) The operation of this clause survives expiry or termination of this Agreement.

### 14. Indemnity

- (a) Each of the parties indemnify and agree to keep indemnified the other party and their employees, officers, agents and contractors (collectively personnel) from and against all loss, damage, liability, cost and expense (including reasonable legal expenses on a full indemnity basis) sustained or incurred by those indemnified, arising out of or in connection with any:



- (i) negligent, willful, unlawful or fraudulent act or omission on the part of a party or any of its personnel in the performance of this Agreement;
  - (ii) breach by a party or its personnel of the confidentiality and privacy obligations under this Agreement.
- (b) TIPIAC indemnifies You from and against all loss or damage suffered by You arising from a claim that the TIPIAC Resources (except where the infringement occurs from using Bilaar AI) infringe a third party's Intellectual Property. TIPIAC is not liable for, and provides no indemnity in respect of, any claim arising from:
- (i) Bilaar AI Output,
  - (ii) Your use of Bilaar AI Output, including any modification, combination or application of that output; or
  - (iii) Any Bilaar AI Inputs provided by You or Your personnel or students.
- (c) You indemnify and agree to keep indemnified TIPIAC and their employees, officers, agents and contractors (collectively personnel) from and against all loss, damage, liability, cost and expense (including reasonable legal expenses on a full indemnity basis) sustained or incurred by those indemnified, arising out of or in connection with a breach by You or Your personnel of the Intellectual Property, credit and integrity, and ICIP obligations under this Agreement.
- (d) A party's obligations to indemnify those indemnified is reduced proportionately to the extent that any act or omission on the part of the indemnified or its personnel contributed to the claim or loss.
- (e) To the maximum extent permitted by law, the total liability of a party under this Agreement will be limited to the Membership Fees payable under this agreement, excluding liability:
- (i) under clause 14(c); and
  - (ii) in connection with the personal injury or death to any person or damage to, or loss of tangible property.
- (f) The operation of this clause survives expiry or termination of this Agreement.

## 15. CHANGES TO THE TERMS

- (a) TIPIAC may vary this Agreement from time to time by giving You at least 30 days written notice of any variation via our website and by email (and You consent to receiving email communications for this purpose).
- (b) Where TIPIAC varies this Agreement in accordance with clause 15(a), You can terminate this Agreement by providing written notice to TIPIAC no later than 14 days before the change is due to take effect and Your Membership Fee will be refunded on a pro-rated basis.

## 16. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement is governed by the law in force in New South Wales, Australia. Each party submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the New South Wales courts.



## 17. ASSIGNMENT

A party may not assign or transfer this Agreement or any of its rights or obligations hereunder, without the other party's prior written consent.

## 18. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement (including TIPIAC's Privacy Policy) constitutes the entire agreement of the parties about its subject matter and supersedes all previous agreements, understandings and negotiations on that subject matter.

## 19. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS

TIPIAC will send You information relating to Your account (eg. payment authorisations, invoices, changes in password or payment method, confirmation messages, notices) in electronic form only.

## 21. DEFINITIONS

**Bilaar AI** is a closed and controlled artificial intelligence system that is built on the foundation of respect, interconnectedness, and sustainability, and which draws on TIPIAC's knowledge systems, First Nations knowledge systems, and publicly available research papers, curriculum documents, and websites to respond to written prompts. It is intended to guide educators and organisations toward authentic cultural inclusion and understanding for non-commercial educational and teaching purposes.

**Bilaar AI Inputs** are the prompts or information the user puts into Bilaar AI to produce the Bilaar AI Outputs.

**Bilaar AI Outputs** are the end product of a user's use of Bilaar AI, ie the resource that is created following a prompt being inserted in Bilaar AI.

**Commercial Purpose** means any use of the TIPIAC Resources or Bilaar AI Output for sale, profit, or other commercial advantage, including creating, adapting, or incorporating them into any product, service, or material that is sold, licensed, or otherwise made available for a fee. It also includes any reproduction or use that would interfere with or undermine TIPIAC's ability to commercialise, license, or otherwise exploit its intellectual property.

**Indigenous** means Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander.

**Indigenous Cultural and Intellectual Property** or ICIP refers to the rights of Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to their heritage. Heritage comprises all objects, sites, languages and knowledge, the nature or use of which has been transmitted or continues to be transmitted from generation to generation, and which is regarded as pertaining to a particular Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander group or its territory, and includes:

- (a) literary, performing and artistic works (including songs, music, dances, stories, ceremonies, symbols, languages and designs);
- (b) scientific, agricultural, technical and ecological knowledge (including cultivars, medicines and the phenotypes of flora and fauna), spiritual and traditional knowledge (including knowledge of Country);
- (c) all items of movable cultural property;



- (d) human ancestral remains and tissues;
- (e) immovable cultural property (including lands, waters, and skies, sacred and historically significant sites and burial grounds);
- (f) documentation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples' heritage in archives, film, photographs, videotape or audiotape and all forms of media;
- (g) cultural practices including caring for Country practices; and
- (h) secret and sacred information, knowledge and practices.

**Intellectual Property** means all copyright, patents, registered and unregistered trade marks, registered designs, trade secrets and know-how, Confidential Information, all rights under any legislation relating to the protection of computer programs, circuit layouts and all other intellectual property as defined by Article 2 of the 'Convention Establishing the World Intellectual Property Organisation' dated July 1967, but excluding Moral Rights;

**Moral Rights** has the meaning given to it by the *Copyright Act 1968* (Cth);

**Malicious Computer Program** refers to viruses, Trojan horses, worms or any other computer programming that may damage, modify, delete, detrimentally interfere with, access without authority or expropriate any system, data or Personal Information that may cause damage to TIPIAC's property or the property of other individuals.

**Membership** means the membership type You have selected under clause 3(b) and Schedule 1 – Memberships.

**Membership Fee** means the fee payable by You for the Membership, as set out in Schedule 1 – Memberships or as notified to you in accordance with clause 4(g).

**Non-Commercial Purposes** are purposes other than Commercial Purposes, and include educational and teaching purposes including use by Your students.

**Personal Information** takes its meaning from its definition under the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth).

**Sensitive Information** takes its meaning from its definition under the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth).

**TIPIAC** means trading as TIPIAC Pty Ltd (ABN 98 646 508 698).

**TIPIAC Resources** means the teaching resources available to members and as set out under clause 3(b) and Schedule 1 – Memberships.
